Footnotes

SAME AS was reluctant to load, bumped with a rival at the start, went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, ranged up leaving the backstretch, was coaxed along in the three path on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, took the lead while put to a drive in upper stretch, shook clear into the final sixteenth under a right-handed whip then was eased up late while best. AIN'T HESITATIN was rated while eager in the two path on the first turn, raced near the middle of the field under restraint, advanced three wide under urging on the far turn, made an outside bid under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, battled with the winner into the final furlong, lost touch with that foe in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to hold the place. SHUTTER SPEED was unhurried while saving ground, jostled with SANDANA HEAT nearing the five-sixteenths pole, swung six wide into the stretch, gained ground into the final furlong, moved in while improving position and was along for the show. GASLAMP saved ground on the first turn, settled nicely off the pace, was roused while in the three path on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. R M MONEY TALKS raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, bobbled while behind horses at the three-eighths pole, went two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, moved out some while under a drive and also lacked the needed response. MUSGRAVITE went four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, was urged along between horses while in the two path on the far turn and came up empty. SHUGACOATTHELAW was eased back just off the pace on the inside, dropped back at the half-mile pole, saved ground under urging on the far turn, lacked room behind opponents near the three-sixteenths, moved out in the final furlong and failed to respond. SANDANA HEAT was taken back early, raced near the rail on the first turn, lingered at

the rear, jostled with SHUTTER SPEED while in the two path nearing the five-sixteenths, swung seven wide into the stretch and was no factor. WILSPERFECTSUCCESS bumped with an opponent at the start, raced in the two path on the first turn, contested the pace on the inside of BIG LIL RED, dropped back leaving the backstretch, was urged along while inside on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and tired. SAINT NO MORE bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled near the back, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. BIG LIL RED lugged out into the first turn, was eager while three wide on that bend, moved up to contest the pace on the outside early on the backstretch, dropped in entering the far turn, vied along the rail on that bend, lost the advantage under a drive in upper stretch and faded.
