Footnotes

GIMLET stalked the leaders while racing five-wide, moved up to engage with a furlong to run, vied and edged away late. KISMET'S HEELS was bumped at the start, settled off the leaders from between foes, moved seven-wide through the second turn and finished with good energy to gain the place. CITE was bumped at the break, raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, lacked racing room, angled in nearing the three-sixteenths pole, reached the fore with a furlong to run, vied with the winner but could not match strides late. HINT OF ROSES settled off the leaders early, moved up while racing five-wide nearing the five-eighths pole, vied into the lane and gave way through the final furlong. NANA LOOCH set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when challenged after going three-furlongs, vied into the lane and gradually gave way. MOLLYDOOKER settled off the leaders early, saved ground through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and did not menace. LITTLE SCOTTY pressed the pace while racing three-wide, moved up to offer a bid nearing the five-eighths pole and weakened in the drive. ELWOOD'S ADVICE was void of early speed, saved ground into the lane and did not menace. BALLIVOR raced off the pacesetters early, moved three-wide through the second turn and weakened. ARRIBA CAUSEWAY showed no early speed, raced three-wide through the second turn and was not a factor. COLD BLOOD raced four-wide through both turns, gradually weakened and was

eased through the lane.
