CRONINTHEBARBARIAN was unhurried three wide early, continued outside moving past horses rapidly under his own power around the far turn, ran past the leaders in upper stretch and drew off under a drive. LUCK OF THE KITTEN raced three wide around the first turn, was outmoved by the winner around the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished well to clearly best the others. GIMLET was well back through the opening half-mile, raced three to four wide around the far turn and rallied for the show spot. SOLUBLE (GER) saved ground early while well back, remained outrun three to four wide around the turn and improved position late without threatening. LIGHT THE NIGHT dueled inside BOBCAT through a hotly contested pace down the backstretch, remained prominent to midstretch and weakened. SEMBLANCE OF ORDER raced evenly two wide and lacked a rally. MUNJAZ (GB) steadied at the start and was off a couple lengths slow, raced on the rail through the early going while trailing, circled four to five wide on the far turn and passed only tired horses. STOCKYARD stalked the duelers along the rail and was finished by the top of the stretch. BOBCAT broke outward in front of MUNJAZ, dueled outside LIGHT THE NIGHT through a sharp half-mile and tired.
