GIANT RUN angled in closer from the outside after the start, continued rated under snug hold, pulled wanting to do more in early stages but was well handled and settled in, began to inch way up closer in the far turn, circled up five wide then was set down driving four deep, took over the lead and finished clear. OSCAR NOMINATED was taken in hand in opening stages to settle in off the early pace, continued under a hold racing three deep in the backstretch, commenced steady advance in the far turn, dug in five wide off top flight at the sixteenth pole, fought gamely to get nose down in front for runner up spot. TWO STEP TIME raced two wide in the first turn then continued unhurried off the early leaders, roused for response approaching upper stretch, dug in four then three deep, was well handled, gamely weaved way through, split foes late then got nipped for place at the wire. GIMLET was taken back at the start, continued reserved near the back, picked up the pace along the outside in the far turn, got pinched back at the start then remained unhurried near the back, saved ground along the inside, got through along rail entering upper stretch then raced in traffic, lacked racing room and got out too late. MIGHTY MO

showed speed at the start and continued near the lead in the first turn, began to duel for the top spot racing along the inside of FRANKLIN TOWERS then took on added challenge of STOCKYARD, continued to battle through the far turn and upper stretch, could not move on in final furlong and gaveway. STOCKYARD raced just off the early leader then edged up to duel along the outside, continued to match strides racing three deep in the far turn, battled back in upper stretch then had nothing in reserve for deep stretch. BERLINER stalked midpack in early stages, made move two wide in final turn, briefly lacked room then gained position but failed to produce needed kick. J R 'S HOLIDAY was well reserved racing in the back, showed response along the rail, lacked racing room and altered course late. FRANKLIN TOWERS held narrow lead in opening quarter then came under challenge from rivals, dueled throughout the backstretch, far turn and into the lane, had no closing kick in reserve for late drive. STRIKE MIDNIGHT raced off the pace, commenced bid in the far turn, drifted out approaching top stretch then lacked needed rally for late impact.
