CHAULK O LATTEY sped to the early lead, dueled inside, inched clear in the stretch, drifted out late but held gamely under some left handed urging. SHOW STEALER angled in on the first turn and chased inside, cut the corner into the stretch and rallied along the rail. HIKING chased three deep on the first turn then outside a rival, went between horses on the second turn and rallied between foes through the stretch. ZANBO angled in and dueled outside the winner then between foes, continued alongside the winner on the second turn and went on willingly late. TIZ A KISS unhurried inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and finished well. WARREN'S JEN FIZZ chased outside a rival then three deep between foes into the stretch and was outfinished. EGYPTIAN EMPIRE settled alongside a rival chasing the pace, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and had a mild late bid. QUEENOFTHEPALACE (NZ) saved ground chasing the pace, came out some for room in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TAYLOR LANE stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. JOSEPHINE'S MOMENT stalked outside, bid four wide on the backstretch, tracked three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. MARGOT

MACHANCE (GB) stalked off the rail, bid three deep between foes on the backstretch, fell back some on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and weakened. SWEET AS A ROSE stumbled badly at the start and unseated the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start before ruling SWEET AS A ROSE was the cause of her own trouble.
