TIZ A KISS saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and closed willingly to just miss. SHOW STEALER chased along the inside, continued on the rail on the second turn and through the stretch and went on willingly for the show. FREETHINKER angled in and settled outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was outfinished. WARREN'S JEN FIZZ prompted the pace outside the winner to the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and weakened some in the final furlong. QUEENOFTHEPALACE (NZ) chased outside a rival or off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HIKING five wide in the chute, angled in and stalked outside a rival then between foes on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response.
