EVO CAMPO (IRE) stalked inside, split horses on the second turn, rallied under urging and wore down the runner-up late. BERT'S MELODY stalked the pace outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter to gain the advantage leaving the backstretch, inched away and angled in on the second turn, kicked clear and held on well but was worn down nearing the wire. HIKING angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and between foes into the stretch, continued inside in the final furlong and bested the others. CAUSEWAY CAROLYN stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch and three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. SORESCA (IRE) bobbled at the start, chased just off the inside, came out leaving the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. JOLENE angled in approaching the first turn and saved ground to the stretch, came off the rail in the drive and did not rally. BIG BREAK sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, continued inside and had little left for the stretch.
