Footnotes

SWEET AS A ROSE stalked outside a rival, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, bid three wide under urging in midstretch, had the rider lose the whip a sixteenth out but gained the lead and inched away late. WARREN'S JEN FIZZ had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, took a short lead in the stretch, fought back along the rail in the final furlong but could not quite match the winner late. HALLJOY (IRE) angled in and dueled outside the runner-up, fought back between horses in midstretch and held third. TIZ A KISS steadied in tight early, chased outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. FOOLISH WAYS (IRE) angled in and settled a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out in the stretch and split rivals with a late bid at a minor award. CIRCLING (IRE) stalked three deep, angled in outside a rival on the second turn, was between foes into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHAPELY saved ground stalking the pace, continued inside into and through the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. HIKING a bit slow into stride, steadied sharply in tight early, settled a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the second turn and could not offer the necessary response. ARTISTICDIFFERENCE pulled and steadied between horses early, saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail into the second turn and did not rally. SHOW STEALER stalked between horses then inside leaving the second turn and weakened. STRIDING OUT (IRE) broke a bit slowly, steadied in tight early, settled off the pace inside, came out some in the stretch and lacked a further response.
