HARD NIGHT'S DAY stalked outside a rival then inside down the hill, came out in midstretch and rallied under urging to get up nearing the wire. ILLUMINANT had good early speed and dueled inside a rival then inched clear a bit off the rail, set the pace just off the inside, drifted inward in midstretch and held on well but could not contain the winner late. ENTEBBE settled inside, came out leaving the hill and three deep into the stretch, came out again in upper stretch and just got the show four wide on the line. MARGARET REAY chased outside then three deep on the hill and four wide into the stretch and was edged for third between foes on the wire. GENTLE HUMOR dueled outside the runner-up then stalked alongside the winner down the hill, came three deep into the stretch, continued between foes through the final furlong and was edged for a minor award. HALF PAST MIDNIGHT chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the hill, continued inside in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. STURDY ONE broke a bit slowly, settled outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. FASHIONED GEM stalked the pace inside, was in a bit tight off heels midway on the hill, continued along the rail in the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
