BOWIE broke in at the start and was corrected, cut a swift pace just off the inside very lightly coaxed, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in leg weary and held safe to prevail as a late closing pair latched on at the finish. SPECIAL RISK chased three to four wide from near the rear, came under urging three furlongs from home, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly for the place honors latching on the winner at the wire. TORRENT off a beat slow, chased three wide from near the rear, got out into the turn with seven-sixteenths to run to the five path carrying out SHE'S HAD ENOUGH six wide midway on the bend, cornered six wide for home, offered up late foot to rally in tandem with SPECIAL RISK issuing a tepid threat to the winner inside the final sixteenth and was along for the show honors. JUMBY BAY stacked four wide early on, chased three wide through the turn under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, continued three wide for home, offered up mild energy to be along for the last major share. LA CORONEL three to four wide in pursuit coaxed along from the get go, swung three to two wide into upper stretch, gained on the leg weary front through the drive while offering no serious kick. MY SWEET STELLA hustled from the start, chased the pace along the inside under urging from the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch, made no impact. SUNDAY GRAVY coaxed from the gate, chased two to three wide coaxed along from the get go, continued two to three wide for home and tired. SHE'S HAD ENOUGH four wide in pursuit early on, got carried out six wide midway on the turn by TORRENT who got out with seven-sixteenths to run, shifted inside to the three path once that foe cleared inside, swung three wide for home and trailed throughout.
