ZERO ZEE was bumped from both between rivals shortly after the break, as a result of VICTORY TO VICTORY failing to keep a straight course after springing from the gate, took up the chase drafting behind and taking advantage of being covered up by COURTMEWITHCARATS, swung out be about six wide by the three-sixteenths marker, charged to the front during the run leading up and through the furlong grounds to lead a hoarde by a slim advanrage, dug in gamely in the final stages to fend of a pair of foes. MALIBU STELLA made some contact with COMPELLED a few strides after the break, departed the backstretch from the three path, angled five wide into upper stretch, remained unasked for her best from the top of the lane to the general area of the sixteenth marker, having a less than ideal seam between foes all the while, bodily burst through at that station to challenge for command, finished willingly but got staved off. COMPELLED made contact wkith equines from each side in short order after leaving the gate, travelled three wide on the turn, commenced the stretch a couple of paths farther off the rail, had a good finish down the outside of the course to secure the show award. JUMBY BAY broke in line with IRISH FIX, contended for the top for a spell side by side with that foe before dropped back into a stalking role by the end of the backstretch, sat within striking distance from the two path, got put to strong handling at the five-sixteenth pole, was near hat path heading home, lugged in at the three-sixteenths pole, leading the rider of VICTORY TO VICTORY to steady and suffer a temporary loss of momentum, lugged in once more in midstretch, causing both IRISH FIX and BANNER WAVE to get checked hard, flattened out, yet held on well enough for the last major check. VICTORY TO VICTORY broke to the outside, was taken hold but not before bumping with ELITE HEIR and causing a few more rivals to get involved in a bumping incident too, raced two wide on the bend, was forced to kept on hold, placed behind a wall of foes at the quarter pole, got carried over closer to the rail in upper stretch by an errant JUMBY BAY, with the pilot ultimately steadying, managed to get going once more, steadied a second time in the vicinity of the sixteenth marker, avoiding becoming entrapped in a blindswitch by gaining the clearance to tip out towards the middle of the course, gained some ground with only a minor

slice fo show for it. ELITE HEIR nudged to the outside by the breaker in the next stall, bumped with that one as well as another, dashed over to the rail right afterwards and rode it to the quarter pole, fanned out wider and wider in a search for optimal clearance during the first half of the stretch until becoming eight wide by the beginning of the final furlong, then mustered up a mild response. COURTMEWITHCARATS sparred as the widest of three briefly down the backstretch, chased the front runners from the same path on the turn, was more in the four path by the head of the stretch, remained prominently placed for an additional furlong before tiring. CARA BLYTHE dueled for command from the two path and gave way. BANNER WAVE underwent a ground-saving journey, got roused cutting the corner into the lane, was looming a threat, granted with quite a few others, when forced to check when put in tight in midlane, never regained interest. IRISH FIX vied for command from the rail, had already been displaced by the winner when bothered by a wayward foe and forced to check right around the eighth pole, steadily retreated thereafter.
