COVER SONG chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the second turn, steadied in tight at the quarter pole then angled in, came out in upper stretch and bumped with the runner-up nearing midstretch, then rallied between rivals under left handed urging to gain the lead in late stretch and gamely prevailed. DANILOVNA (IRE) broke slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, came in a bumped with the winner nearing midstretch then finished willingly four wide. BARLEYSUGAR (IRE) settled inside chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and finished willingly to get up for the show. LADY VALEUR (IRE) stalked off the rail or outside a rival and three deep leaving the second turn, bid between horses in deep stretch and also continued willingly. BELVOIR BAY (GB) pulled her way to the early lead and angled in outside a rival, inched away on the first turn then angled in, set the pace inside, turned back a pair of bids into the second turn, inched clear and was overtaken late. DREAMARCHER angled in and chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and steadied when crowded and was outfinished. NODIAC (IRE) also angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail for room in the stretch and could not quite summon the needed late kick. LOOKOUT SISTER four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. SWEET DRAGON FLY (GB) broke slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace to the stretch and could not summon the needed response. GREAT PAGE (IRE) pulled along the inside to force then stalk the early pace, came off the rail on the backstretch, bid between horses nearing the half mile pole, tracked the leader just off the rail on the second turn and weakened in the drive. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the former initiated the contact then both runners contributed to the bumping between them.
