Footnotes

EASY GRADER stalked off the rail, bid between horses into the stretch then outside the winner in midstretch, gained a slim advantage past the eighth pole, drifted in a bit from the whip then gamely prevailed under left handed urging. PARASAIL sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, fought back into the stretch, drifted out a bit from the whip past midstretch and continued gamely to the end. LONGSTOCKING stalked between horses then off the rail into the stretch, steadied briefly behind the top pair nearing the sixteenth pole and continued willingly. ASHLEY'S SASSY pulled some then fell back outside then off the rail, angled in alongside a rival leaving the hill, came out four wide into the stretch and finished well. YANA stalked outside then three deep on the hill and four wide into the stretch and was outfinished. PEACH COVE (NZ) chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the hill, came three wide into the stretch and went between foes late. COMPLIMENTARY saved ground chasing the pace, came out in the stretch, steadied off heels when

between rivals late. FERVENT FEMME stalked three deep then outside the winner, bid three wide into the stretch and was outkicked. REVENUE VIRGINIUS outside a rival early, stalked inside down the hill and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. DAME STREET chased between horses then inside, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. Claims of foul by the rider of LONGSTOCKING against each of the top two for alleged interference in deep stretch were not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the gap between the top pair closed before LONGSTOCKING got there. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
