WATCH THIS CAT had good early speed and dueled off the rail then inside, inched away in the stretch and held sway under urging. MADAME STRIPES (ARG) dueled three deep then stalked outside a rival leaving the hill, continued a bit off the rail in the stretch and held second. LONGSTOCKING stalked outside then three deep on the hill and into the stretch and was edged for the place. TRYST chased between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the hill, continued inside in the stretch and was outfinished. FERVENT FEMME chased off the inside, came four wide into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary response. STURDY ONE settled between horses then outside a rival leaving the hill, came out in the stretch and split horses late. YANA chased three deep then outside a rival on the hill and into the stretch and did not rally. OUR FIRST GIRL angled in and chased inside, steadied in tight past midway on the hill, continued inside and did not rally. PARASAIL dueled between horses then outside the winner leaving the hill, came out in the stretch, was in a bit tight while weakening in midstretch and dropped back. ASHLEY'S SASSY settled off the rail, came out leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch and wide not rally. MYSTERIOUS MIRACLE bobbled some in a bit of a slow start, saved ground off the pace, continued inside in the stretch and was





not a threat. MY PALMILLA stalked a bit off the rail then angled to the inside past midway on the hill, dropped back and drifted out in the stretch and was eased late. Rail on hill at zero.
