

MATTERHORN made some contact with STORMIN MONARCHO at the break, remained towards the inside bringing up the back of the pack proceeding down the backstretch, was let out a notch a short distance before from the half mile pole, continued to ride the rail, picked up interest when put to a drive leaving the five-sixteenths marker, had some room to attempt to cut the corner into the lane but chose to go outward instead, chopped way at the deficit, began to drift out a bit once past the furlong grounds, yet successfully wrested away the advantage from the second place finisher, himself drifting out slightly, then edged away. STORMIN MONARCHO bumped lightly with the winner as the field was sent on its way, moved up into a forward position to engage TRANSPARENT, struck the front, albeit by the slimmest of margins, coming to the end of the backstretch, put away that opponent as three-quarters was being completed only to have the top one, fully revved up, posing a danger, got pounced upon right after stepping toot into the stretch, relinquished while starting to drift out a bit at the beginning of the final furlong, had no trouble though securing second. SAMRAAT took up the chase from the two path, commenced to ge angled out from the five-sixteenths pole, completed the maneuver four to five wide, made no headway after getting straightened away. TRANSPARENT disputed the pace two wide for three-quarters and gave way. SALTO DEL INDIO (CHI) raced from off inside, was in the three path wnen put to a drive right around the three-eighths pole, tired.
