APPEALING TALE coaxed to the front shortly after the start, cut the pace in hand just off the inside safely in front, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, edged away under a drive, had his margin cut into late on while holding well to prevail. RED VINE stumbled at the start then was bumped both sides and squeezed back due to pressure from TAMARKUZ breaking outwards and MATTERHORN breaking inwards, settled just off the inside in mid pack, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, cut the corner into upper stretch, rallied with good energy to cut into the winner in the late staged while along for the place honors. HONOR CODE brushed the near side stall at the start, saved ground near the rear under light coaxing from the get go, came under a drive three furlongs from home, angled out from the five-sixteenths to be five to six wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to garner the show honors while unable to threaten the winner to the wire. TAMARKUZ broke out at the start under coaxing and bumped RED VINE then squeezed that foe back in tandem with pressure from MATTERHORN who broke inwards, chased three to four wide forwardly placed under urging with five-sixteenths to run, spun three wide into upper stretch, fought on to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. MYLUTE bumped at the start by MATTERHORN and in turn bumped RED VINE, then was pinched back between foes due to pressure on both sides, chased four to five wide from mid pack, came under encouragement with three furlongs remaining, continued four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. SCARLY CHARLY three wide in range of the leader, got ridden along five-sixteenths from home, cornered two to three wide at the head of the stretch and tired in the lane. MATTERHORN broke in at the start bumping MYLUTE into RED VINE and squeezing that pair back in tandem with pressure from TAMARKUZ breaking outwards, got ridden along three to four wide at the rear from the get go, swung five to six wide into upper stretch and trailed.
