STALLWALKIN' DUDE shied away from an incoming CHAPMAN but not before bumping with that rival, raced from off the inside throughout, briefly drafted behind the leader on the turn, but primarily took up the chase two to three wide, got set down entering the stretch, made minimal progress during the run through the furlong grounds, gained ground more readily thereafter, showed good determination to snatch the verdict away nearing the finish line. BRASS PEAR off to a sharp beginning, quickly cleared the competition, carved the pace from the inside, loosely pressed and while initially kept under a firm hold by the pilot, got let out after completing the half, dug in well when challenged in earnest by the top one with under a furlong to go, got nipped. LEILANI'S TICKET three wide on the turn, was placed into the five path at the head of the stretch, lacked the needed late response. ROUND was pushed out slightly after being bumped shortly after the start, took up the chase from the two path on the turn, was driven towards the fourth one heading for the three-sixteenths marker, mustered up a mild response. READ THE MIRAGE hand urged keeping watch on the front runners from the pocket, came up empty. MATTERHORN saved ground on the turn, angled into the six path from upper to midstretch, made no impact. CHAPMAN broke to the outside, was pulled off the winner but not before making contact, failed to menace. HARPOON bumped soon after leaving the starting gate, departed the backstretch from the three path, was outrun.
