



REVVED UP forwardly placed in hand in the two path, attended the pace of ARCHIE to the outside through the first pair of turns before ranging up to take over into the backstretch with five and a half furlongs to run, showed the way unhurried given some rein nearing the far turn, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home under challenge as the pressure intensifed in behind, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in coming under threat a furlong out to the inside, had that rival get on near even terms inside the eighth pole, battled back gamely and stubbornly to fend off the challenge and prevail at the finish by a hard fought neck. DEEPLY UNDERVALUED broke out at the start bumping with HAVANA MOON who broke inwards, settled just off the pace in hand behind the cover of REVVED UP, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch in behind foes, darted to the rail three-sixteenths out as ARCHIE backed away leaving the seam, rallied up the hedge to issue a threat through the final eighth showing good energy to get on near even terms nearing the sixteenth marker, dug in tenacious but was ultimately rebuffed to the wire by an equally game rival. IMPERIA four wide through the opening bend, attempted to advance to tuck three wide and had HAVANA MOON speed up inside to block that attempt, was eased off to tuck in behind that foe and raced three wide through the second turn settling just off the pace, came under coaxing three furlongs out continuing three wide through the far turn, cornered three wide into upper stretch, ran on to just hold for the show honors. MANITOULIN just off the inside near the rear behind the cover of DEEPLY UNDERVALUED, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled three to four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. MISSION DRIVEN saved ground in reserve in mid pack behind the cover of EAST BAY LODGE, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid through the stretch but could not impact the top quartet. EAST BAY LODGE tracked the pace along the inside in range of the front in the early going, came under a ride at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid but was outkicked through the stretch. HAVANA MOON broke in at the start bumping solidly with DEEPLY UNDERVALUED who broke outwards, raced three wide in range, got given some rein approaching the wire the first time around to block the attempt of IMPERIA advancing outside to tuck in front, came under urging five-sixteenths out, continued just off the inside for home and weakened in the drive. BINGO KITTEN two to three wide near the rear, came under a ride with seven-sixteenths remaining, swung two to three wide for home, offered no response. ARCHIE established the front and showed the way under rating along the inside and under attendance from REVVED UP but zero pressure from the outside, had that rival take over the front with five and a half furlongs to go and sat content tracking along the hedge, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch prominent before backing away to the finish. SANDYINTHESUN hit the off side stall at the start getting away last and conceding four to five lengths to the front, saved ground at the rear, came under coaxing with three-eighths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and trailed throughout.
