VERY MAEVE came away without apparent mishap, cut over to the inside, kept watch on the duelers from the pocket, was cued up angling outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole, spun three wide into the stretch, under a drive by now, closed in on the ones to catch, drew even with approximately a sixteenth remaining, cemented itself to the front in short order, drifted out a bit in the late stages edging away, rider flashing the whip from the right side as a corrective measure. PRINCESSOFTHIEVES pursued the front runners from the three path on the turn, commenced the stretch one path farther off the rail, mustered up a good kick down the center of the course to garner the place. HAWK ALLEY broke from the gate in unison with HUNDRED YEAR STORM and would remain locked side by side with that foe throughout, never headed by the nemesis once the dispute began in earnest, made it over to the rail in time for the run around the bend, got put to a drive still fully engaged with aforementioned rival, and with the eventual winner starting to make her presence, left the eighth pole seemingly holding her largest lead, a short length the best choice to gauge its measurement, got collared by the winner in the general area of the sixteenth pole, lost out on place belatedly, but went on to win the private war with HUNDRED YEAR STORM to earn the show award. HUNDRED YEAR STORM narrowly out-broke the competition, got hooked in a contest with HAWK ALLEY for command covering the duration of the event, was at all times the outer member of the fight and always the one playing catch up after the first strides had been completed, raced two wide on the turn and was in the same one stepping into the stretch, vied willingly to the end, but had to settle for the last major check. ON THE LIST put to hand encouragement almost right from the start, rode the rail on the turn, got set down after more than halfway around the turn, angled out in upper stretch but had no offering. MOOD SWING underwent a ground-saving journey and failed to menace. BAJAN BREEZE left the post parade early, came away in fine shape once the field was sent on its way, sat in the two path in midpack to the end of the bend, swung three wide into the stretch, had no response when asked for one soon afterwards.
