Footnotes

LUCKY RAMSEY attended the pace between horses, launched his bid four wide entering the stretch, quickened inside the furlong marker and nailed ALASKAN PRINCE in the final yards. ALASKAN PRINCE vied between horses through the first turn, assumed command from his stable mate on the backstretch, turned back the challenge of OPTICAL midway through the second turn, shook clear into the stretch, boxed on with good courage but was unable to resist the winner. SHINY BADGE settled saving ground, angled to the far outside with three furlongs to run to mount his rally, kicked on well and was making up ground. TWENTY GAUGE settled between rivals, took closer order through the second turn, angled in and got through entering the stretch, loomed a danger but was bottled up and flattened. RENEGADE RIVER broke slow, settled in hand, advanced between horses but failed to seriously threaten. OPTICAL tracked the pace three deep, moved up to engage the leader on the second turn, but weakened between runners and faded. THUNDERCLOUD was close up four to five wide through the second turn and faltered. TALES OF WAR passed only the tiring ones. ZIMMERMAN contended five wide for six furlongs and dropped out. ON A HEATER was away in good order, set a clear pace into the first turn, relinquished command to his stable mate and settled along the inside, but came up empty on the second turn and faded fast.
