OPTICAL set the pace off of the inside, opened clear into the backstretch, repelled the challenge of LO'S JOURNEY and kicked away. LO'S JOURNEY broke a step slow, mounted a long drive five wide, came to level terms on the second turn, was unable to match strides with the winner and was all out to hold the place. DRUNKONMOCHA tracked the pace toward the inside, offered a mild bid leaving the second turn, but lacked the needed late response. MR. SENSIBILITY contended along the inside, shifted out on the second turn, but failed to make headway through the drive. BIG BROWN SEVENS settled saving ground, tipped out entering the stretch and made a belated gain. CONGRATS TO CUCOS was allowed to settle, had the jockey lose his irons on the first turn, recovered his pedals before going a half but went evenly thereafter. CAN'TMAKE'EMHAPPY was fanned wide into the first turn and lacked a response. GUALAMO (FR) prompted the pace three wide to the second turn and retreated. KING SAILOR showed little. IN THE CARDS was through after a half.
