**Footnotes**

A HE'S AN O'PRADO bumped with a rival at the start, raced inside on the first turn, was rated towards the front, came under urging while inside on the far turn, moved off the rail outside the quarter-pole, chased under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, took the lead near the furlong marker, drifted out under a left-handed whip late and proved best under strong urging. PICKED was bumped at the start and forced in, went three wide on the first turn, was hard ridden on the backstretch, raced three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, gained ground into the final furlong and finished willingly for the place. DEEP EXPLORER was hustled from the start, raced in the two path on the first turn, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, was asked once straightened for the drive, jumped gate tracks at the three-sixteenths, lost the lead at the furlong marker and was outfinished while able to get the show. OPTICAL raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved in late on the backstretch, was urged along while inside on the far turn, chased under a left-whip in upper stretch, loomed a threat into the final furlong while just behind the leaders, switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and was out-kicked. UPTOWN TEMPO broke in and bumped soundly with PICKED then bumped with DUKE OF CHATNE, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, dropped in some in the vicinity of the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. DUKE OF CHATNE was bumped after the start, raced in the two path on the first turn, lingered near the back, was urged along while inside on the far turn and was no factor. SAINT ROCH went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and lacked the

needed response. GLORY KINGDOM bumped with an opponent at the start, went two to three wide on the first turn, settled under some urging, was ridden along while two to three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SHORTY TOWN floated five wide into the first turn then dropped to the three path, stalked the pace on the outside, chased two then three wide on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 27 Feet)
