**Footnotes**

BLACK CANARY away forwardly, retained a prominent position, stalked the pacesetter while taking the two path on the turn, was almost at the three-sixteenths marker before getting called upon for more, drifted into the three path while forging to the front during the remainder of the trip to the eighth pole, with the runner up looming boldly one path closer to the inside, shifted back into the two path after the last of three right handed shots, meeting up with ORECCHIETTE who had just moved along the right border of the inside route herself, saw the twosome lean upon each other for a few jumps before the bumping began in the final seventy yards, numbering four in total, with the middle two best described as being soundly in nature, and the final one more of a brush, dug in gamely to preserve the decision. ORECCHIETTE made some contact with an errant TAKE A STROLL as well as getting momentarily pushed out right after the break, went on to secure the pocket, patiently kept watch on the front runners, angled out coming to the furlong grounds, was between rivals moving up to hitch onto the winner, went inward and into a tight fit along the rail after scooting past the former pacesetter, either shied or shifted slightly back to the outside in deep stretch, raced directly side by side with the top one, bumped lightly once, then solidly twice before brushing with BLACK CANARY, all in the final seventy yards, was game, but ultimately denied. BELLAVAIS settled along the rail, was coaxed loosely drafting behind the second place finisher, got eased into the two path at the head of the stretch, required strong pressure on the right side altering course to the outside of SPANKER past the eighth pole, was steadied late after nearly making contact with the same rival later, closed in willingly to secure the show. SPANKER sat reserved in the two path, swung four wide into the stretch, moved out slightly late from some stick work, held well for the last major check. FOREIGN AFFAIR unhurried in the two path, began the final furlong approximately six wide, shied outward in the shadow of the wire while rallying. TWO HOT BETTY broke the second slowest by one length, raced in the two path, fell back, reaching out greenly from the top of the bend to its midway point, went six wide heading for the three-sixteenths marker, in hand at the time by the pilot, was put to a hand ride and picked up speed altering all the way to the two path in midstretch,

making some headway. K J WARRIOR two wide stepping onto the turn, was fanned five wide into upper stretch exiting it, lacked the needed response. MATINEE BABE pursued the pace three wide on the turn and made no impact. HAPPY MOTORING broke the slowest by two lengths, caught leaning on the left side of the starting gate as the field was sent on its way, was put to some hand encouragement to join up with the others, rode the rail to midstretch while never reaching a contending position afterwards. TAKE A STROLL came out at the break, momentarily carrying out the runner up while bumping lightly, emerged from a tight bunch with a narrow advantage right afterwards, cut over to the inside, showed the way being pressed by a rated BLACK CANARY, had the rival get cued up issuing a challenge coming to the three-sixteenths pole, gave in readily and retreated. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident in the stretch, in addition to a claim of foul lodged by the rider of ORECCHIETTE against the rider of BLACK CANARY, the result was allowed to stand and the race was declared official.
