Footnotes

MIDNIGHT PLEASURE between horses early, chased outside a rival then off the rail, bid three deep leaving the second turn, gained the lead in the stretch and inched away late under urging. DANGERFIELD had speed inside then stalked the leader, took back and came out into the turn, bid between horses to gain the advantage leaving the turn, fought back inside in the stretch, could not match the winner late but was clearly second best. TERM OF ART chased outside then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and held third. CAMINO DE ESTRELLA unhurried off the rail early, angled in approaching the turn, came out into the stretch and was edged for the show. SURF SHACK dropped back off the rail early, continued outside a rival leaving the backstretch, split foes with a forward move on the turn and bested the others. VIBE between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn and weakened in the stretch. OREJAS broke a bit slowly, saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the turn and weakened. FARLEY had speed outside the runner-up then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, dropped back leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch.
