POPULAR KID chased off the rail, went up outside leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, bid three deep to gain the lead in midstretch and inched away under left handed urging late. ROYAL SEEKER stalked between foes then a bit off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter to gain the lead leaving the second turn, inched away, fought back inside foes in midstretch and held second. MARQ ONE a half step slow to begin, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the backstretch and into the second turn, swung three wide into the stretch and was edged for the place. TREADWELL saved ground stalking the pace, inched forward leaving the second turn then waited off heels and steadied briefly a quarter mile out, got through along the fence into the stretch and could not quite summon the needed late kick inside. LOUD STALKER chased three deep then outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch, bid between horses in tight a furlong out, steadied between foes nearing the sixteenth pole and was outfinished. OREJAS in a bit tight at the break, had speed between foes then angled in and set the pace inside, dueled briefly nearing the quarter pole, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened.
