PATRIOTICANDPROUD was unhurried early, shifted into the three path in the far turn, had no room at the top of the lane, angled out around horses, rallied late and drove past the leader in the final stages. DAC chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn while taking over command, cleared the field into the lane but was ran down in the late stages. KLISZ dueled early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and yielded late in the stretch run. GABRIEL'S CAT was bumped around and squeezed back early, trailed the field, shifted into the four path in the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch drive. BOURBON HAPPENS tracked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch. GREAT MINDS stalked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and faded late. SAFFRON HALL was bumped at the start, swung into the six path in the far turn. ALPHA

KITALPHA was never involved. SPORTSCASTER came in at the start, dueled early and was empty late. CLAYMAKER showed little.
