WAR DANCER was a bit keen going by the wire for the first time and raced under a snug hold, edged up closer in early backstretch and applied outside pressure to CHARMOIS, continued to press the pace then moved up to challenge for the lead in the far turn, matched strides into upper stretch then took over and finished clear. CHAMOIS raced on top in the first turn, came under pressure from WAR DANCER and continued to set a pressured pace throughout the backstretch, challenged and vied for the lead in the far turn, kept on but was no late match for eventual winner and held place. MORNING CALM was reserved and raced in the back of the pace, hustled up the inside in the far turn then angled out three wide, finished with a strong kick and was getting to place in final strides. DYNAMIC IMPACT stalked the pace racing between rivals in the backstretch, came under a ride while racing two wide in the final turn, continued steady effort in the lane but was not enough to impact the late leaders. PATRIOTICANDPROUD stalked racing long the inside, came under a ride in the far turn, urged along the rail at the head of the lane, could not sustain bid and steadily weakened. POWERFUL INSTINCT steadied in the first turn then edged up closer along the outside, was rated in contention racing along the outside in the backstretch, hustled up for response then gaveway at the quarter pole.
