HOLIDAY STAR chased the pace early along the five path, stayed in the five path entering the lane, took over command in the stretch, drifted out a bit and held off rivals in the final stages. CHARMING KITTEN was well placed early from the five path, swung into the six path in the final turn, made a bid in the stretch and was gaining in the final stages. ST. ALBANS BOY was up close into the backstretch, shuffled back a bit through the final turn, fanned into the seven path entering the lane with a late gain in the stretch run. THATCHER STREET stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the final turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung in the late stages. DIVINE OATH was back early, fanned into the eight path in the final turn with a belated gain in the stretch drive. KALAMOS shifted into the three path in the final turn while making a bid but flattened out late in the stretch. MARKET OUTLOOK pressed the pace early, shifted into the three path entering the lane and weakened late. ALDOUS SNOW was never a threat. PATRIOTICANDPROUD set the pace early, angled off the rail entering the lane and gave way in the stretch.
