SHARED BELIEF four wide into the first turn, stalked outside or between horses, went up four wide into the second turn, advanced three deep on that turn, took the lead four wide into the stretch, was ridden along to kick clear and was under a long hold the final sixteenth. MORENO bobbled at the start, had good early speed and dueled between horses then outside a rival, inched away a half mile out and again on the second turn, drifted out into the stretch, was not a match for the winner and just held second. CATCH A FLIGHT (ARG) stalked the pace three deep, split rivals on the second turn, angled in leaving that

turn, continued toward the inside in the stretch and was edged for the place. HARD ACES chased outside then between foes into and on the backstretch, continued just off the rail on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. BRONZO (CHI) broke in and bumped a rival, went five wide into the first turn, chased outside, continued four wide into and out of the second turn and could not offer the necessary response. DYNAMIC SKY between foes early, chased off the rail, came out into the stretch and also lacked a rally. YOU KNOW I KNOW angled in early then settled outside a rival, went between horses on the backstretch, split foes on the second turn and could not offer the needed late kick. IMPERATIVE bumped at the start, settled outside then three deep on the backstretch and into the second turn, came out five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. SR. QUISQUEYANO angled in and prompted the pace inside then stalked along the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. COOL SAMURAI pulled along the inside then came out in the run to the first turn, chased outside a rival then between horses leaving the backstretch, was in a bit of traffic between foes early on the second turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. PATRIOTICANDPROUD angled in and saved ground off the pace, split horses on the second turn and was not a threat. DIAMOND BACHELOR stalked the pace inside, dropped back on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gave way. CRIMSON GIANT close up tracking the pace between horses, dropped back inside on the second turn and had nothing left for the stretch.
