Footnotes

SWAPL broke slowly, moved up inside nearing the turn, got through rallying between horses with a quarter-mile remaining, was then presented with a large opening at the top of the stretch, went through and drove clear inside the final furlong, then held off PUZZLED LOOK in the closing yards. PUZZLED LOOK (GB) was outsprinted two wide to the top of the lane, split horses near the eighth-pole and finished well to narrow the gap late. SCANDALSKEEPCOMING pressed the pace three wide between horses, was under right-handed pressure when the rider lost the whip at the top of the stretch, then was outfinished

while drifting out steadily to wind up near the outer fence. ADMIRAL'S WIN steadied soon after the start when QUEEB angled in, was outrun two to three wide to the stretch, then rallied willingly to get fourth near the wire. SIX TONSAFUN set the pace two wide surrounded by challengers to the turn, edged clear briefly and moved to the rail in upper stretch, then was outfinished through the final furlong. MAKE BIG MONEY pressed the early pace on the rail, dropped back through the turn and had no further response. HUNDRED YEAR STORM was crowded soon after the start inside QUEEB, raced three wide around the turn and failed to rally. STARSHIP REINA was within striking range four to five wide around the turn and lacked the necessary late response. QUEEB angled in causing crowding after the start, pressed the pace four wide into the turn and tired. MIDNIGHT TALE pressed the pace five wide to the turn and was finished before reaching the stretch.
