NORTHERN SCREAMER abandned the inside route by tipping into the two path midway down the backstretch, moved by a tiring PRETTY SMART and re-tucked along it, bid strongly prior to cutting the corner into the stretch to gain a narrow advantage, steadily drew clear, kept busy to the end. MIA AND MOLLY parked out in the four path after an apparent clean getaway, closed in and challenged as the half was being completed, proved no mach while finishing well ahead of the others for place honors. SMOK'N STROLL was off a length behind the penultimate breaker, entered the turn three wide, exited it one path wider, mustered up a mild kick sufficient enough to claim the show. HASHTAG BONNIE off the inside throuthout, shied out coming to the end of the backstretch, disputed the pace from the three path, the outermost of three front runners, remained at it until upper stretch then gave way. STAR OF THE NILE bumped into KYNESS after bobbling at he start, took up the chase from the two path, failed to menace. HUNDRED YEAR STORM argued for control positioned between opponents in the two path and tired. KYNESS bumped at the start, was outrun early, angled into the five path coming to the three-sixteenths pole then was outrun late too. PRETTY SMART saved ground, vied inside two rivals, was done by the five-sixteenths pole and got eased.
