Footnotes

AFLEET MARY was allowed to settle early, saved ground through the second turn, angled out approaching the stretch and finished with a late rush to prevail in the closing yards. BESIDE STILL WATER settled off the leaders from between foes, moved three-wide through the second turn, angled out further in mid-stretch, gained a slight edge late but could not hold the winner off from over the top. LITTLE BIT LOVELY sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, remained in control through mid-stretch but could not resist the closers late. CARTA REGIA lacked early foot, raced six-wide through the second turn and did not threaten. INDYGITA was forwardly placed early, moved four-wide through the second turn and lacked the needed closing response. SMOK'N STROLL lacked early speed, raced three-wide through the second turn and failed to rally. SWEET MIRI broke in the air, raced unhurried early, saved ground through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and did not threaten. TYBAL'TS QUEEN chased the leaders while racing four-wide and gradually weakened. OXIDADA chased the leaders while racing three-wide and weakened in the drive. STORM SWEPT raced off the pacesetters from the inside, steadied nearing the eighth pole while giving way and continued to retreat. KIZUNA settled off the leaders early, moved five-wide through the second

turn, angled in nearing the three-sixteenths marker and was not a factor.
