DYNAMIC DECISION broke well and quickly established control, cut over to the inside, was well rated on a loosely-contested lead, continued along the same scenario all the way to the quarter pole, settled in upper stretch before getting switched over to much more active handling, held on long enough and sufficiently so to remain in the clear at the wire. SOUL MAN responded positively to the rating tactics being utilized by the rider for nearly six furlongs, quickened when let out a notch coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive a few strides later, entered the stretch and closed in mild success from upper to midlane, altered course sharply to be five wide with an eighth to go, mustered up a good burst of energy after finishing this maneunver to garner the place. IT MATTERS well well held while keeping an eye on the winner in the pocket, was put to some encouragement after more than halfway around

the far turn, angled out after making it into the furlong grounds, lost out late for second. BRITANNIA'S MOAT put to a firm hold by the rider, shied out briefly and away from some pressure coming from left side during the final stages of the abbreviated run leading onto the main course, stalked the winner from the two path, remained forwardly placed until midstretch before weakening. CODY'S NOTES saved ground and lacked the needed late response. HOON (IRE) raced three wide on both turns, commenced the strech one path wider, had no rally. HUSHHUSHMUSH unhurried in the two path early, got placed four wide at the top one, rallied mildly to mainly improve position. MOMMA'S MARK settled into the two path in midpack, swung three wide into the stretch, made no impact. WHIPPO underwent a three wide journey to the quarter pole and had no offering. MANGOLD was briefly nudged to the outside making its way onto the main course, sat within range in the two path, tired. TALLADEGA strung out three wide on each turn, was outrun. KERRY BOY quickly sent over to the rail, never got involved.
