## **Footnotes**

SOUL MAN saved ground, steadied when blocked in upper stretch, swung to the six path in mid stretch, closed with a flourish and swept to the lead late. ZOO circled the far turn, entered the stretch five deep, drifted in badly when sprinting clear near the sixteenth pole and missed. GURSKY, five deep in upper stretch, drifted in on rivals near the eighth pole and rallied mildly. TAKE A LEFT stalked the pace three wide, challenged for the lead between horses in upper stretch and was caught in tight quarters in mid stretch. LONGING TO TRAVEL, a forward factor in the four path in mid stretch, steadied when forced in by GURSKY near the eighth pole. DEPOSIT SLIP saved ground around the far turn, eased out to the two path in upper stretch and was in tight quarters near the eighth pole. STREET PASSAGE stalked the pace, was steadied behind a wall of horses leaving the far turn then weakened. DIRECTORY prompted the pace two wide, gained a short lead mid way on the far turn then gave way the final furlong. SIDELING HILL set the pace along the rail and surrendered in upper stretch. DREAMIN OF BETTY trailed.
