VEYA stalked the pace from the beginning, took control after about a half mile and was clear from there. TENDER MAY sat off the pace eagerly on the rail, responded well and ran evenly down the stretch. SOUL MAN showed no early speed, angled towards the rail at the top of the stretch with a bold response late. MR. ABUNDANCE took the four path into the first turn while sitting off the pace and ran evenly down the lane. J. S. WILDAR sat towards the rear from the start and had a good response in the stretch. FEASIBILITY sat well off the pace early on and had a feasible move on the outside at the three eighths pole but failed to sustain his run. FRESH WINE was asked for run after half a mile but was never involved. SILVER PEACH was the early pace setter but stopped in the stretch. WHATATA MOOSE broke in the air and trailed from there.
