LUCKY LEROY BROWN raced in the middle of the pack, rallied three-wide into the stretch and edged away late under strong urging. SOUL MAN stalked the pace, bid for the lead entering the stretch and battled gamely. SUPER CAUSEWAY stalked the pace, bid between rivals entering the stretch and battled to the end. SUPER BEAU sprinted clear, set the pace to the final furlong and tired. DIAMOND BLUE trailed to the stretch and had no rally. CERTAINLY STRIKING was no factor.
