Footnotes

KNIGHT OF VALOR forwardly placed three wide, sensed the dawdling early pace and ranged up in hand to take over command with six furlongs to run in a heady move, showed the way settling into a comfortable rhythm through sensible splits patiently handled until nearing the quarter pole, swung just off the inside for home roused for the drive, drew clear under a drive to the eighth pole, saw some of that margin cut into while holding clear to prevail. READY

STRIKE saved ground in reserve in mid pack, came under urging five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick unable to reel in the top one while chasing that rival home clear of the rest and second best. STRONG two to three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under a ride five-sixteenths from home, angled out five wide into upper stretch, ran on for the show honors. MONTAUK MAN broke out at the start bumping and pinching back TOM'S VISION against UNDERCUTTER, settled just off the inside in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home and improved position for the last major share. GEO NIKO four to five wide near the rear, got coaxed along at the three-eighths, angled out seven wide into upper stretch, kept on through the stretch but was just nipped for the last major share. THOMAS KNIGHT chased four to five wide from mid pack, took the overland route coming under urging midway on the turn, made a four wide bid to reach contention through the latter portion of the turn and swung four wide for home, couldn't sustain the move flattening out in the final eighth. FUHRIOUS WARRIOR just off the inside near the rear, tucked to the hedge five furlongs from home, came under urging with three furlongs remaining, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, passed tired foes. AMERICAN PHANTOM away well, was under a firm hold showing the way, a reluctant leader out of the dog legged turn into the backstretch, conceded the front to KNIGHT OF VALOR and tracked that rival along the inside in hand, came under urging five-sixteenths from home, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. TOM'S VISION got bumped at the start by MONTAUK MAN and was pinched back against UNDERCUTTER, chased three wide from the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths, swung three to four wide into upper stretch and offered no response. UNDERCUTTER two to three wide just off the pace, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, swung three wide into upper stretch and faltered. SIR MAURICE forwardly placed three to four wide, got lightly coaxed along midway on the far turn in retreat, swung five wide for home and folded. LUCKYBUCK SYNDROME broke in at the start and was corrected, settled three wide in mid pack, gre detached at the rear of the field after completing a half, came under light coaxing midway on the far turn, swung three to four wide for home well behind and was eased through the stretch.
