Footnotes

MARTINI KID tracked the pace of DANGEROUS BEND from the inside, angled out with a furlong to run, quickly drew clear and held safely. BRUCARITA settled off the leaders early, moved four-wide through the second turn, could not reach the winner in the drive but finished well to gain the place. MOEGAN AVENUE was reserved just off the leaders from between foes, moved three-wide through the second turn, reached DANGEROUS BEND nearing the quarter, vied with that rival and gave way in the closing yards. DANGEROUS BEND sprinted clear soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace,

responded when challenged by MOEGAN AVENUE nearing the quarter, vied with that foe and gave way through the final sixteenth. MAV settled off the leaders from the inside, steadied nearing the five-sixteenths pole, moved three-wide through the second turn and did not threaten. STRONG raced five-wide through the first turn, settled off the leaders early, moved three-wide through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. KID JETER lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. FRIED BALONEY was bumped repeatedly soon after the start, lacked early foot, raced four-wide through the second turn and was not a factor. BELLY DANCER was void of early speed, raced five-wide through the second turn and did not threaten. CLASSY O'PRADO chased the leaders while racing three-wide for a half and weakened. ZAP CAT was bumped at the start, raced four-wide through the first turn, chased the leaders for a half, weakened and was eased through the lane. THAT'S NOTHIN was bumped repeatedly soon after the start, chased the leaders while racing four-wide four three furlongs, weakened, was pulled up and walked off.
