**Footnotes**

STRONG edged up leaving the first turn and applied pressure to WONDER FROLIC, duelled along the outside of rival through the backstretch and around the far turn, shook free at the head of the lane and continued clear under steady urging. WONDER FROLIC led the way in the first turn then came under pressure from STRONG, duelled along the inside of rival through the backstretch and far turn, could not match strides at the head of the lane, fought back but was no match late. BIG CITY HEART came out four wide in the first turn, stalked the top leaders in the backstretch, launched a bid for the top two at the head of the lane, continued steady two to three wide bid in the lane and raced along for show. FOREVER DI was allowed to settle in early stages, hustled up three wide entering the lane, angled out further and finished with a kick. DISTINCTIVE STYLE stalked the pace along the rail in early going, continued inside bid in upper stretch then angled out and lacked late needed kick. HOPE IS RISING was unhurried in the backstretch, hustled up along the outside in upper stretch but failed to produce needed rally. CAT'S WARRIOR pulled along the rail in the first turn, settled back off the early pace, came out wide in upper stretch and had no late impact. EVERYTHING GOES raced in contention racing between then along the outside, lost position three furlongs out and failed to move back up.
