SIGNATURE LOOK came away in good order, moved in behind the leading quartet as they went at it on the initial straightaway, raced in the two path early on the first turn then dropped to the rail, was well spotted just off the pace, eased out a couple of paths late on the backstretch, stalked the leader in the three path on the far turn, was asked while having dead-aim near the quarter-pole, rallied to the lead under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and edged clear under strong urging. KNIGHT OF VALOR took part in a four way pace dispute early while between horses, came out into the first turn then bumped with IT'S A GIVEN, went four then three wide on that bend, stalked the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, drew on even terms for the lead after turning into the stretch, battled with the winner under a drive into the final furlong then was outfinished

while able to hold the place. GUNLOCK dropped back early, raced in the two path on the first turn, was unhurried near the back, went around the far turn in the three path, angled out while put to a drive just after turning into the stretch and finished willingly on the outside to get the show. TASK FORCE GLORY raced inside early on the first turn then came off the rail, settled in the back half of the field, went around the far turn in the two path, was roused at the five-sixteenths, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch and improved position to get the last spot in the superfecta between foes late. CRAFTY COLONEL raced in the two path on the first turn, settled comfortably in the middle of the field, moved closer late on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, angled out under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. AMERICAN ROAD was part of a four-way pace dispute while inside on the initial straightaway, lugged out a bit into the first turn, raced in the two path early on that bend then dropped back to the rail, set the pace, vied inside on the far turn, was given his cue at the five-sixteenths, lost the advantage in upper stretch and weakened. STRONG sparred for the early lead while the outermost of four, was bumped into the first turn and carried seven wide, dropped to the three path shortly thereafter then the two path late on that bend, settled off the pace, raced in the two path on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip and lacked the needed response. HANNO was last away, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, went two then three wide on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths and failed to threaten. FUHRIOUS WARRIOR went three wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, moved closer while urged five wide on the far turn but came up empty. THAT MAKES SENSE was hustled from the start, raced in the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, dropped back while inside on the far turn and capitulated. IT'S A GIVEN disputed the early pace between horses, was bumped by KNIGHT OF VALOR entering the first turn and forced into STRONG, went six wide early on that bend then dropped to the three path, was forwardly placed on the outside, came up empty in the four path on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch and stopped.
