FLAMINGO LANE established the front and showed the way rated in hand along the inside under attendance to the outside while uncontested, remained patiently handled through comfortable fractions until the pressure in behind began to intensify through the latter portion of the far turn, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, inched away under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in holding well to the end to prevail. SILVERVILLE saved ground near the rear behind cover, came under urging three furlongs out, spun just off the inside for home under a drive, angled out to the four path with a sixteenth remaining and surged late outside to just latch on to the winner at the wire and procure the place honors in the last jump. TAP IT OUT tracked the pace in reserve behind the cover of the leader, angled out three wide into daylight at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild kick to chase the winner home in closest pursuit through the final eighth, then was nailed in the last jump by the late surging aforementioned foe and forced to settle for the show honors. TANGO TIME (IRE) off slow conceding three to four lengths to the front, settled just off the inside at the rear in hand, got steadied very briefly and lightly early on off heels when just newly into the backside, bided her time tracking at the back, shifted briefly to the three path near the five-sixteenths before tucking quickly back inside as FALL TO FAITH backed out and got put to encouragement just inside that station, cornered just off the inside for home, took to the rail straightened away and offered up a mild bid for the last major share being outfinished late on. GIANT'S JEWEL attended the leader under a firm hold from the three path until tucked in a path with nine-sixteenths to go, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch issuing a challenge for command, got shaken off nearing the eighth pole and weakened in the late stages. SWEET CORINE three wide in mid pack, shifted to the four path with nine-sixteenths to go, took closer order midway on the turn before coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, cornered four wide for home unable to sustain the mild bid and made no impact. FALL INTO FAITH just off the pace in hand just off the inside, took to the three path with nine-sixteenths to go before coming under coaxing half a mile out, advanced mildly on the front into contention midway on the far turn, came under a drive through the latter portion and faded nearing the quarter pole continuing three wide at that station, then tired in the stretch.
