TANGO TIME (IRE) was guided into the pocket after the start, sat within range of the front runners, being patiently handled, was forced to remain on hold, stuck behind the pacesetter, that is SUSIE'S A COWGIRL, from the five-sixteenths pole to end of the second bend, found enough wiggle space and got eased into the two path at the head of the stretch, idled along behind a pair of foes, lacking enough room to launch a rally of her own, espied a freshly-developed seam open up in the vicinity of the furlong marker, had the rider commit to go through, boldly went on to split rivals to grab away the advantage for good a couple of jumps shy of the sixteenth marker, kicked away, crossing the wire put to a brisk hand ride. QUEEN OF SCAT stayed along the inside route after the break, was allowed to settle into stride, was much like the eventual winner, forced to await usable options during the final stages of the run around the second bend, gained some space to move up once the top one herself abandoned the hedge, remained caught in traffic sufficient enough to prevent her from being fully extended, paused in hand before getting angled outward past the furlong grounds and proceeded to take the same lane as the top one did once that opponent was safely through it, unleashed a strong kick to win place honors in a blanket finish. NECK OF THE MOON ducked outward as the field was sent off and running, was pulled off the nearest rival in time to prevent any contact, appeared unsettled, nesilted amongst others heading for the beginning of the clubhouse turn, chased the pace from the two path, fanned out into the five path from upper to midstretch, had a good finish down the center of the course to secure the show. COMING ATTRACTION prompted the pace from the two path, got turned loose for the drive home, held well to the end although denied an in-the-money placing. SUMBA SUNSET coaxed two wide early, travelled in the three path on the far turn, flattened out. FLYING TIPAT sat reserved in the two path for the opening three-quarters, shifted out into the sixth one from upper to midstretch, lacked a solid late closing response. SUSIE'S A COWGIRL quickly established control, showed the way from the inside, rated unkindly by pulling on the bit until the top of the backstretch, went about more professionally afterwards, felt an increase in pressure after stepping onto the far turn, and even more of it nearing the quarter pole, was put to a drive, held out on the front end until a short distance from the sixteenth pole, then backed away. UNBRIDLED SONYA broke in an awkward manner to the outside, raced three wide on the first turn, was put to some hand urging mustering up a four wide run from the midway point on the far turn, reaching a strong contending position by the quarter pole, failed to sustain the move and gave way.
