Footnotes

LOLA'S THE ONE went to the front, raced a bit off the rail on the first turn, set the clear pace, controlled the action in the two path on the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held under mostly a strong hand ride. PICASSO MOON went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused in the three path on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, pursued the winner under the whip in the drive and finished willingly while second best. GO STELLAIRE bumped solidly with a rival at the start, was well placed on the inside, chased along the rail on the far turn, pursued the winner under a drive in the stretch and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. VIA FRATTINA raced in the two to three path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was given her cue in the three path on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong then weakened. UNFADING BEAUTY was taken up while inside on the first turn, settled along the rail, moved off the inside late on the far turn, was asked while three wide into the stretch, moved out under a drive before the three-sixteenths and improved position. MORTY was eager in the early going, raced in the two path on the first turn, settled more kindly on the backstretch while on the outside, was asked in the three to four path on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. ESTRELA CADENTE saved ground on the first turn, came out early on the backstretch, settled towards the rear, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, moved out under a drive near the three-sixteenths and failed to threaten. AUDACIOUS GAL bumped soundly with CAROLINA HONEY twice at the start, was hard held while rank into the first turn, raced in the two path on that bend, was reserved off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed

response. O'SUGAR BEAR went three wide on the first turn, was forced out early on the backstretch, raced three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. TOOTSIE PIE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and came up empty. CAROLINA HONEY was bumped on both sides at the start, raced near the rail on the first turn, lagged at the rear, saved ground on the far turn and showed little. (Rail at 25 Feet)
