FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, March 14. \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes on the turf in 2015 allowed 2 lbs.; a graded stakes on the turf since October 1, 4 lbs.; a graded stakes or two races other than maiden, claiming, or starter since September 1, 6 lbs. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. In the event this stakes is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 14, 2015 with 26 Nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile).

WAR CORRESPONDENT settled off the leaders early, saved ground through the second turn, angled out approaching the stretch, responded to steady urging and wore down ARIPEKA in the closing yards. ARIPEKA dueled for the lead from the inside with EXCAPER, disposed of that rival after going three-quarters, opened a clear lead into the lane, remained safe through mid-stretch but could not resist the winner late. GRAND TITO raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the second turn and finished with good late energy. DRAMEDY showed no early foot, raced far wide through the second turn and found his best stride late. MR. ONLINE was void of early speed, saved ground through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and showed some late run. EXCAPER disputed the pace from the outside with ARIPEKA and gave way after going six furlongs. LOCHTE settled off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. BREITLING FLYER pressed the pace from the outside and weakened after going a half.
