STAKES Gulfstream Park Turf H. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, January 29. \$2,500 to enter and \$1,000 to start. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weights: Saturday, February 4. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at the time of entry, with weight to be assigned at that time. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given by assigned weight, then by highest career earnings. In the event this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth) (RRail at 36 feet).

Footnotes

ALMANAAR (GB) was headstrong first time through the stretch and stumbled after appearing to clip the heels of LUKES ALLEY, settled down two wide into the backstretch, moved out four wide willingly late on the far turn, was roused through upper stretch and finished strongly to get up in time outside. BEACH PATROL set the pace along the inside while pressed by EIRIGH, disposed of that one and was challenged by WAR CORRESPONDENT into the stretch, then drifted out considerably under left-handed pressure to bump solidly with that foe in deep stretch. ALL INCLUDED was outsprinted to the first turn saving ground, remained outrun two wide into the far turn before easing out four wide, angled out further still into the lane and closed steadily on the far outside to get past WAR CORRESPONDENT in the last strides. WAR CORRESPONDENT saved ground within easy striking range, bid two wide outside BEACH PATROL coming off the far turn, drifted out under left-handed pressure through midstretch, then was maintaining a straighter course when bumped solidly by BEACH PATROL inside the last sixteenth. LUKES ALLEY appeared to have his heels clipped by ALMANAAR first time through the stretch, raced mostly two wide on the turns before easing out one path further into the lane and had no rally. DIVISIDERO bobbed and broke outward, was positioned close-up three wide around the turns, bid briefly turning for home and flattened out. FLATLINED was outsprinted early three wide, was forced to go five wide attempting to quicken late on the far turn and was outkicked. EIRIGH was off slowly but recovered first time through the lane to press the pace outside BEACH HOUSE, remained prominent to the far turn and gave way. FOLLOWING A STEWARD'S INQUIRY AND AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF WAR CORRESPONDENT, BEACH PATROL WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND POSITION AND PLACED FOURTH FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH.
