After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds 118 lbs.; Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stake on turf since October 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race since October 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at the time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. In the event this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 108 feet).



## Footnotes

WAR CORRESPONDENT vied along inside of APPLICATOR in first turn and decided to edge back, wanted to go in early backstretch but was well handled and settled into stalking position, awaited cue entering far turn, tapped on shoulder past quarter pole and steadily inched up closer to APPLICATOR, shook reins then shown whip, switched to left handed drive, took command and remained game and clear. APPLICATOR vied along outside of WAR CORRESPONDENT in first turn, took command when rival decided to edge back, continued to set pace by clear margin racing under snug hold, felt eventual winner closing in exiting final turn, set down driving just off inside, fought back but could not move on for late lead, held place at wire. LUBASH settled in nicely off top trio, saved ground racing just off then along inside, crept up closer then roused three to four wide in drive, finished strong and willingly got nipped at wire for runner up spot. OUR WAY stalked along inside in backstretch, continued unasked in far turn, sat patiently then set down for drive, continued in close contention but lacked needed kick to get by.
