Footnotes

MSHAWISH tracked the pace of GOLDEN RIFLE while under steady restraint, waited for racing room from the quarter to eighth pole, split foes in mid-stretch, forged to the front and held SLUMBER (GB) by the narrowest of margins. SLUMBER (GB) settled off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn, reached the leaders in tandem with the winner with a sixteenth to run and just missed. WAR CORRESPONDENT raced unhurried early, moved far outside through the second turn and finished with good late energy. MANCHURIAN HIGH was allowed to settle in stride early, advanced from the far outside through the second turn and finished with a late rally. GRAND TITO stalked the pace of GOLDEN RIFLE from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge into the stretch, vied and gave way through the final sixteenth. AMEN KITTEN was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with late interest. LOCHTE raced off the pacesetters from between foes, moved outside through the second turn, raced in tight quarters through the final furlong and did not threaten late. IMAGINING lagged early, saved ground through the second turn, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole, angled back inside in mid-stretch, checked nearing the sixteenth pole and lost chance for better placing. GOLDEN RIFLE broke in stride to take command at once, saved ground while setting the pace, responded when challenged nearing the quarter, vied into mid-stretch and gave way.
