EIRIGH raced close up inside, moved out for the drive at the quarter pole, split foes at the sixteenth marker and surged late for the win. COCO MON steadied at the start, raced off the pace, bid four wide on the turn and dug in gamely outside through the stretch. WAR CORRESPONDENT stalked two wide, bid three wide on the turn and dug in gamely between rivals to the finish. DUBAI SKY pressed the pace, bid two wide, dueled on the far turn and weakened late. BERN' JAMES BERN set the pace on the inside, dueled and weakened.
