DREAMOLOGIST stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, bid three deep, gained the lead in midstretch and won clear under energetic then steady handling. HUNDI (IRE) broke slowly, chased between horses then inside on the hill, came out in midstretch and edged a rival late for the place. PERDONA pulled between horses and steadied in tight after the right hand curve, chased between foes, came three deep into the stretch and was edged for second. ENTRECHAT dueled between horses then inside leaving the hill, fought back into the stretch and between foes in midstretch and weakened some late. WHISK bumped at the start, chased between horses then inside on the hill and into the stretch, came out past midstretch and was outfinished. WARRENSCRYTALIZED had speed inside to duel for the lead then stalked along the rail, re-bid from the fence in midstretch and weakened late. STURDY ONE dueled four wide then outside a rival leaving the hill, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. LITTLE TREASURE (ITY) broke in and bumped a rival, pulled outside then angled in on the hill, came out three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SEA MONA dueled between horses then stalked outside a rival down the hill, came out four wide into the stretch and weakened. HARD NIGHT'S DAY broke slowly, chased between rivals, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. DEMONICA chased four wide then three deep down the hill, came out five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. INTO OBLIVION broke out and bumped a rival, chased three deep then between foes, dropped back a bit off the rail leaving the hill and had little left for the stretch. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
